

## Program Restructure Plans

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The UW MBA Consortium is currently revising the degree requirements and program curriculum. The updates to the program were approved in mid-December 2019 and the updated degree requirements and program curriculum will launch in Fall 2020. However, select electives can be taken before Fall 2020. Following is an overview of the proposed updates:

### Total required credits = 36 credits



#### Business Essentials Courses (4 credits)

MBA 708: Essentials of Financial Analysis (2 cr)

MBA 709: Essentials of Economic and Statistical Analysis (2 cr)

*\*Students may be able to test out of these courses, but will then take up to four additional elective credits to reach the required 36 total credits.*



#### Required Program Core (22 credits)

MBA 700: Defining your Plan for Success: Program Orientation (1 cr)

- Student services, degree planning, goal setting

MBA 701: Leading a Dynamic and Diverse Workforce (4 cr)

- Teamwork, Leadership, Communication

MBA 702: Making Informed Managerial Decisions (4 cr)

- Budgeting, Forecasting, Business intelligence and analytics

MBA 703: Developing New Products and Services (4 cr)

- Entrepreneurship, Design thinking, Marketing

MBA 704: Competing Strategically in a Global Environment (4 cr)

- Strategy, Globalization

MBA 705: Navigating Change amid Uncertainty (4 cr)

- Change management, Project management, Business process reengineering

MBA 710: Refining your Plan for Success: Program Capstone (1 cr)

- Feedback + Reflection, Career planning + Alumni development

## Example of Course Sequencing and Planning Considerations

Following is an example of how updated degree requirements could be completed, if starting with classes in Spring 2020. If starting in Fall 2020, the example of elective sequencing changes and would be done between Fall 2020 and Spring 2023. The elective sequencing is a suggestion and is open to some flexibility to meet your individual needs.

### Planning Notes

- In order to be eligible for financial aid, a student must be registered in a minimum of four credits in spring/fall, three credits in summer.
- The maximum time to degree is seven years from when your first MBA class was taken. Most students finish in 2.5-3 years, taking about one class at a time.
- In general, we recommend taking 4-5 credits in spring/fall, 1-3 credits in summer, and 1 credit in winter. Each student varies in what they can handle, so there is flexibility to this.
- Required program core classes must be taken in order. After taking the Business Essentials/Module 1, you will be guaranteed a spot in each subsequent module in the following terms, as long as you register for the next class within two weeks once registration opens. If you don't enroll within the two-week window, we can't guarantee you a spot in future terms. You may have to wait until there is an opening in the class you need in a future term, which could delay graduation. We do our best to get students back into the course sequence when they would like, but each class has limited space.
